

ORDINANCE 97-98-4

AN ORDINANCE ELECTING PARTICIPATION IN THE ILLINOIS MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT FUND

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CRETE PARK DISTRICT THAT

WHEREAS, Article 7 of the Illinois Pension Code provides that a unit of government may elect to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund by the adoption of a resolution or ordinance of its governing body, participation to begin following receipt by the Board of Trustees of the Fund of official notice of the election by the unit of government and on a date specified by the IMRF Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Crete Park District, as follows:

1. That the Crete Park District, Will County, Illinois, does hereby elect to participate in the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund.
2. That the standard for IMRF participation shall be a position normally requiring performance of duty for 1000 hours per year.
3. That the Secretary be directed to promptly file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Board of Trustees of the Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund.
